For 0-8 year olds and their grown-ups



You're just like Jack and the Beanstalk, placing your foot on the first rung of the ladder on this fantastic learning journey!

What to expect when you visit the exhibition:

A fun, interactive and immersive exhibition space that offers a unique learning experience!

Each tour is 1 hour long and includes:

- introductory storytelling performance
- exploration and free play that inspires creativity, let the kids get stuck in!
- Finished up with discussion of story ideas at the end

How the day runs:

9:45/10am - Arrival & welcome into our Atrium space which is yours for the day. It can accommodate up to 60 children & has an adjoining toilet area.

10-11am – Tour of exhibition

11-11:20pm – Break in Atrium space

11:20-12:20pm – Workshop

12:20-1:15pm – Option to stay for lunch in Atrium space, then goodbyes!

Schedule for 2 classes (cost £630)

10-11am – Group 1 Tour of exhibition, Group 2 Creative workshop

11-11:20pm – Break in Atrium space (reset & swap)

11:20-12:20pm – Group 1 workshop, Group 2 Tour of exhibition

12:20-1:15pm – Option to stay for lunch in Atrium space, then goodbyes!

We can offer 1 class a stand-alone visit to the exhibition for £210. And we can offer visits for up to 3 classes on rotation of a few activities for a cost of £945.



Creative Workshops

To make your experience here even more magical we suggest taking part in a workshop with us!

Especially if you'd like to bring 2 classes. 😊

Our creative workshops support literacy through playful interactive drama & storytelling. Each workshop is 1 hour long and delivered by an experienced arts educator and is designed to incorporate “speaking, moving & creating” elements within it. The children will work on their confidence and speaking & listening skills in a playful fun way that will harbor a love of stories! All sessions can be adapted to cater for disabled, SEN and EAL children.

We differentiate the workshops for EYFS, KS1 & KS2 to grapple with characterisation and themes within the stories relevant to their capacity.

EYFS - Billy Goats Gruff, Trip Trap Trip What?

Using characterisation, poetry and movement we will explore how to be clever and persuasive in our storytelling.

KS1 - Little Red Riding Hood – Good, bad or misunderstood?

How can we address baddies & villains? How do we stand up to bully's and take action? In this workshop we will look at the concept of villains and how we tell stories through movement and our voices, whilst discussing wider themes of anti-bullying & kindness.

KS2 - Cinderella – Cinderella liberator, let's put a spin on traditional concepts of princesses & princes!

In this workshop we will celebrate heroes and heroines in stories and look how we can we make them more representative of us and relevant to us in a modern equal culturally diverse society.

Each child taking part in a creative workshop will receive a specially designed Fairy Tale Z-arts activity booklet, which has fun activities to fill out in the creative workshop AND is jam-packed with creative follow-up activities to take back to school with you!

You will have a Z-arts person ready to show you about the building and we have a fabulous space to host you for lunch with a brand-new adjacent toilet block.
