
#### Z-Arts is directly opposite Hulme Park

#### Entrance

When you enter Z-arts, you will see a poster, some plants, a fish tank, and some steps. On your left, there is a ramp. If you go up the ramp or up the steps, you will get to our Box Office desk.

#### **Box Office**

This is what you will see as you go up the ramp or climb the steps towards Box Office. When you arrive, the person at the desk will help you get to the show!






#### Z-café

There is a second entrance and exit door located in the café next to the toilets.




#### **Theatre Corridor**

In Z-café, next to the seating area, there is a black door with two windows.

When you go through that door, go down to the end of the corridor.

On your left is a door which takes you through to the theatre.

A Z-arts staff member will direct you to the theatre when the show is about to begin!

When you enter the theatre, there will be a Z-arts staff member there to guide you.

Get comfy and relax. The show is about to start!

#### What to Expect

This show has puppetry, lots of music and doesn't use many words.

Who are the characters we are going to meet? We meet Marty the puppy, whose songs and playtime with his Dad are the best part of his day.

There are no loud noises or other triggers in the show.





## **Useful Questions**

What can I enjoy if I don't understand the story?

This show is accessible for young children and PMLD individuals. Aside from the story, audiences may enjoy the puppet and the beautful lights and music.

If I don't understand speech or don't speak English, what do I get out of your show? Speech is not integral to the show. There are fewer than 10 words spoken in the show, and all reinforced with clear actions eg 'Bathtime'

If I am deaf or hard of hearing, what do I get from your show?

Vivid puppetry, magical lights, and magic tricks. You can 'see' the notes of Twinkle Twinkle played out by coloured stars .

If I am blind or partially sighted, what do I get from your show? You will hear the immersive score throughout and we are happy to arrange pre-show touch tours to meet Marty the dog. Please arrange this with Box Office in advance.

If loud, sudden noises, surprises or 'jumpy moments' frighten me badly, would I be able to be an audience member?


